### **8.2 Liz Breakey, Councillor, Rocky View County**

- County Planning Processes: draft plan from McEllhaney on September 30th. An implementation Committee will be set up to carry the recommendations and needed change to bylaws of the area structure plan. Grants available for implementing the work.
- Provincial Flood Mitigation: Provincial direction on flood mitigation projects to be announced soon.
- Servicing, Connectivity and Hamlet Beautification: 90/120 connections have been completed for the water and wastewater servicing. Deadline for connection is March 2016. Paving of Balsam and White avenue is proceeding and repair of the pathways are in progress.
- Water Quality Study: University of Calgary Profession has proposed a follow-up baseline analysis to monitor cleanup of the alluvial aquifer.
